IMPORTANT NOTES:

- We will use the texts in Inside Reading 1 as an extensive reading material in this Module and **one of texts from Inside Reading 1** will be used on Quiz 2 and **another one** will be used on Module Exit Multiple Choice Exam. You are supposed to inform your students about this, so that they should pay more attention to covering the texts.
- All Writing Sections in English File Intermediate are omitted; the essay pack will be used instead.
- There will be one quiz based on a selected reader book. Our students will be responsible for the entire book. The grade they receive from this reader book quiz – **READER QUIZ** – will count as part of the five quizzes they take. Please make sure to share this important information with all our students and ensure that they have finished reading the book by the quiz day.
- **Writing quiz and writing exit exam** will have two parts: **Part 1** will have exercises like fill-in-the-blanks, circling the correct option, matching, and finding a topic sentence, etc. These questions use the questions, words and grammar structures related to B1+ Writing Pack. **Part 2** will be a writing task.
- If there is a time constraint, teachers are allowed to assign **all photocopiables, videos, workbook exercises, and Revise & Check parts as homework**, taking into account their students' needs, interests, and requests.
- **The speaking quiz** is scheduled to be administered on May 13 at 9.00 a.m. Instructors may continue with their regular lessons following the quiz if they wish.

***Discussion Activity Procedure:**

1. Topic Selection: Each student will be assigned one of two randomly selected discussion topics. Topics will be designed in an agree/disagree format.

2. Assignment Method: Students may either draw lots to determine their topic or choose voluntarily, depending on the instructor's discretion and classroom dynamics.

3. Preparation Time: Students will be given a brief moment (about 2 minutes) to collect their thoughts and prepare key points for their opinion (agree or disagree).

4. Speaking Task: Each student will present their opinion on the assigned topic for approximately 2 minutes. They are expected to clearly state their position and provide at least two supporting reasons or examples.

5. Language Focus: Students should aim to use appropriate discourse markers (e.g., In my opinion, Firstly, However, On the other hand) and persuasive language to strengthen their arguments
